1. What are the subtle ways you are tempted to teach children to function in a pharisaical way?
2. Do your children see themselves as sinners because of what they do or because of what they are?
3. How would your child feel if they sinned? Hopeless? Unable to own up to it? Not bothered? (after all it's all about grace).
4. Are you presenting your children with a big view of God, so that they recognise that only in Him will their hearts find joy and rest?
5. Because we help shape our children it's helpful to ask:
What drives me?

What do I fear, love, feel anxious about?
6. How do you define success?
How would your children complete this sentence? 'What my parents most want for me is....?'
